UK Championship Speedweekend 2019.

Saturday 22nd June & Sunday 23rd June is the UK Championship weekend for all of our Domestic formulas.

All races on Saturday for 1300 Saloons, Rookie Bangers, Gt Hot Rods, Junior Rods & Lady Bangers are qualifying rounds for UK Championships, to determine grid positions for the Championship races, which are the first races scheduled for Sunday 23rd June.

Racing starts prompt at 4pm on Saturday and Sunday at 12 noon. Pit gates open at 1pm on Saturday it's really important you do not arrive before that time. You can stay overnight at the Stadium, Driver is no charge, but everyone else is £20 per unit..

As there are lots of races, we need to sort the race format out; Drivers wanting to race should book in ASAP Text 07798868947 or email drivers@skegway.info. As well as booking in it's as important to cancel your booking if you are not able to attend, again on any of the above numbers.

On Sunday 23rd June, remember to sign in at the pit office to get your log book date stamped BEFORE you go to scrutineering.

GT Hot Rods

Following a successful trial at the last GT Hot Rod race meeting we will continue to steward unnecessary and/or avoidable contact, driving standards etc with the Black flag only. We feel that by removing the use of the black cross and instead only using the black flag it will enhance driving skills and ability throughout the race grids. At the recent drivers briefing all agreed that driving standards must and will improve by implementing this rule for the foreseeable future. It was noticeable how much better disciplined the drivers were on British Championship day, however all drivers must continue to improve and race each other with respect at all times, which is only to be expected within any non contact formula. This will be an ongoing rule until otherwise stated, thank you.

Internet Abuse

Please note anything put on Face book or other social media by a driver or someone associated with a driver can be subject to disciplinary action.

Bridge Stairs

Reminder to all, please do not stand or sit on the stairs to the bridge near race control, the stairs must be clear at all times.

Drivers Log Books

Drivers, it is important that you remember to sign your log book as soon as you receive it

Pit area

The pit area (including the camping area) is not a test track, so its 5mph everywhere! No passengers to be carried in the cars in the pits, and also you can't ride on moving trailers, flatbeds etc when in the pits. Pit Safety is a must!

Drivers need to stop pit lane racing, in particular drivers parking their car in line but not staying within their car and instead walking off. This causes all sorts of problems, and potentially quite serious especially when it's near the ambulance area.

Signing in

Because of the changes at the Raceway, signing in is now done in new pit office, (not at the pit gate). On arrival, park up and go to sign in **BEFORE** going to scrutineering. Your mechanic must go with you to get admission, you will need your log book with you for stamping. (Mechanics trotting along with your logbook at a later time will not gain admission). The only entrance from the pits to the stadium arena for pedestrians is via the new gateway or at the turnstiles. Only towing vehicles with race cars for the event that day are allowed into the pits. Drivers, when going to sign in, please don't drive to the Pit office, and leave you car in the walk way, please walk .And also transporters can't park in the area next to the old building on either side close to the pits office, thanks

Alcohol

All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.

If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyse you, and there maybe consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment .We do have breathalysers at the stadium, and as per the rule book, any driver can be tested through the meeting.

Fuel Caps

After an issue with a fuel cap coming astray during the course of the race, and this was with a National formula, not domestic, with this formula, the drivers mark their fuel caps with their race number, helping officials deal with the issue of a car with no fuel cap far easier. So can we suggest that drivers of our domestic formulas follow suit, and write your race number on your fuel cap, as it is as much benefit to yourselves and fellow drivers as it is to the track staff. This is not compulsory, but is advisory.

Race Results.

Please make sure that someone from your team listens to the race results during the course of the meeting, as these can only be queried on the day of the meeting, not when they are published on line.

Pit Lane

Just a polite reminder, about not lining up in the pit lane too soon please. The hard standing area of the pits is particularly congested this early in the season as we await the back field to dry up with some better weather. Everyone naturally tries to park on the dry/hard standing - which we fully understand. However it does cause extra chaos in the pit lane if more than the next race is actually in line! Therefore nobody should be more than one race too early please, and we must never block the access around the First Aid/Ambulance area at any time.

Parking Reminder

No extra vehicles allowed in the pits, no dropping off tools etc. Also the Area next to the pit lane (old shed) and the walk way to the Pit Office and the track is a NO PARKING AREA.

As a reminder to all drivers, no extra vehicles in the pits. And please park where told too and remember the pits are Max 5mph.

Staff are also reminded they need to park in the main car park not the pits, thanks

And despite many warnings and info you are still bringing extra vehicles into the pits.

Please note, we may take disciplinary action if this continues.

Complaints

any driver/parent wishing to make a complaint, must use the proper channels. At a race meeting, go to the box with your driver's rep, this must be done during the race meeting, and you have till 30 minutes after the last race ending. After the meeting, they must go via the official channel, info@skegway.info or 07881 021058 not via social media.

Children in the pits area

Just a polite reminder, that children in the pits, must be supervised by an adult at ALL times.

Booking in to Race

Thank you to all the drivers that take the time to book in to race, as by booking in to race, it enables us to give out accurate booking lists for the public, and also enables us to plan the race formats for the meeting. It is especially important to book in for Championship meetings to enable us to finalise grids etc. We know that is not always possible, but if you do intend on racing, but unsure on whether you are able to due to work etc, then you can always book in on a provisional booking, so we know that you are intending on racing if circumstances enable you to, and then you can confirm or withdraw the booking nearer to the date of the meeting. Just as it is important to book in, it is equally important to cancel a booking if you have already booked in to race, and for whatever reason you can no longer honour that booking. It would be nice to think that we could get to 100% bookings.

Booking in has never been easier, you can either book in by text (or reply to the booking texts when sent out) on **07798868947**, by email to drivers@skegway.info or via the **Skegness Raceway Drivers page** on Face book, either by private message or when a provisional booking list goes on, put your booking in the comments.
