Junior Rod 361- 3 Months ban for serious racing misconduct.

All drivers are reminded that drinking alcohol before & during a race meeting is not allowed.

If you are involved in an accident on track, the authorities may well breathalyze you, and there may be consequences. Also if you have to be seen by the First Aid & go to hospital, there is a chance that you cannot receive treatment.

All Drivers please remember to book in as soon as you know you are racing, and it's equally important to cancel if you know you can't make it.

We are always looking for people to help at the stadium on race days in all departments. If you would like to be involved with a hardworking, friendly, under paid team of racing enthusiasts than this is for you. If you feel you have the skills than please ring 0844 559 1228 for details. We particularly need someone to train as a lap scorer & timekeeper, (working the lap top), training will be given and you get to see the racing in the dry!!!

All Drivers are reminded that the speed limit in the pits & this includes the back grass field, is 5mph. Please do not exceed this speed, there is always kids running & playing around.

TAKE CARE !!!

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times, this includes pits & back fields.

Scrutineers

Checks on cars will be ongoing all season, you may be asked to draw a golf ball out as you leave the track, depending on what colour you pull, you may be required to go to scrutineering bay, to have some checks done.

Please note the new rule for 2016

During a race, you must not exit your car whilst on track or on the infield. The only exception to this is when you are in extreme danger within the car, for example in the case of fire. In this case you must exit the car with extreme care, always remembering that there is a danger of other competitors on track. You should then make your way to the nearest Safe Area. These designated 'Safe Areas' will be identified at the driver's pre meeting briefing or written Drivers Instructions.

When you remain in your car on the track, keep your harness and helmet on, until the end of the race or until the race is cautioned or stopped. You should then make your way to a designated Safe Area as noted above

What should I do if I need to stop my car because of mechanical failure during a race?

Retire to the Infield as soon and as safely as possible. When you have retired to the infield, remain in your car, keeping your harness and helmet on. You must not get out of your car even under yellow or red flag stoppages, just remain in your car, until the end of the race.

Rookie Bangers reminder

Team racing is not allowed, and if you continue with it the driver you are helping may well have their places removed from the results.

STRUT BRACE - ROOKIE BANGERS

With immediate effect drivers are now permitted to fit a strut brace to their rookie bangers.

This brace connects the leg tops, must be made using a maximum of 1 and a half inch box or tubing 3mm thickness and must be bolted NOT WELDED to the leg tops. The brace is free and MUST NOT have any other brackets/attachments/connections and MUST NOT be attached to any other part of the car or engine.

This strut brace is purely for the purpose of holding the legs up to help prevent camber and for no other reason!!

We will be continuing with stringent check on engines in the Rookies and remember bans can & will be issued for irregularities.

We have re-introduced the buying car policy, where the Promotion can buy a Rookie Banger (less safety equipment, Manifold, Carb.) for £200. If a Driver refuses then the same rule applies where if a part is not left for checking, the Driver is deemed to be illegal and will be subject to a BOC.

The annual Rookie Bangers under 25yrs Championship race will be on Sunday 6thNovember, the race is eligible to any Rookie Driver aged 25yrs & under up to & including 6thNovember, current list of Drivers; The Annual Award is sponsored by Tony Cooke from TCM racing.

Transponders

Cars are required to have a Transponder fitted for lap scoring purposes for the start of 2017 Season, these will be the AMB/MyLaps Transponders and the model types can be 260DP, 260, 160DP, 160, the "DP" refers to it being a Direct Powered one, i.e. no internal rechargeable battery, the cheapest type that is compatible with the MyLaps System is the 160, as this is aimed at Karting it will work perfectly fine [stoxkarts and national mini's use them].
